First hired as Director of Legal Affairs, Ms. Roiter served for more than 20 years as Secretary General and Vice-President of the Legal Department of Loto-Québec. She has held the position of President and Chief Executive Officer for more than three years, the Government of Quebec having made her the first woman to hold the highest office in the organization.

Its reputation and expertise in the field of gambling extend far beyond the borders of Quebec. Ms. Roiter acts as Secretary General of the World Lottery Association, an international organization bringing together more than 140 public lottery companies from some 80 countries.
